In the Name of Allah, Who Came in the Person of Master Fard Muhammad, and in the name of His Last and Greatest Messenger, the Honorable Elijah Muhammad. As-Salaam-Alaikum.

In addressing thousands of Black people in Chicago each week during the summer of 1972, the Honorable Elijah Muhammad stated one Sunday, during his "Theology of Time Series", words to this effect: *In Islam you cannot do as you please because some of your pleasures may not please Allah (God)*. Such a profound truth as this teaches us the importance of refining our individual and collective personalities, especially as we present ourselves in the highest civilized settings among our own people.

Islam is the original religion or way of life of the Blackman and woman, and it is practiced daily by all members of the Black Nation who insist on always representing their best selves. This act, among others, guarantees advancement and the onward progression of original civilization.

Personalities grow and develop because of the existence of people. Dictionaries define the word personality, among other things, as (1). *"the complex of characteristics that distinguishes an individual or a nation or group"*; (2) *"the totality of an individual's behavioral and emotional tendencies,"* and *"the organization of the individual's distinguishing character traits, attitudes, or habits"*.

People develop their own individual personalities based on things such as life experiences, educational training, inter-

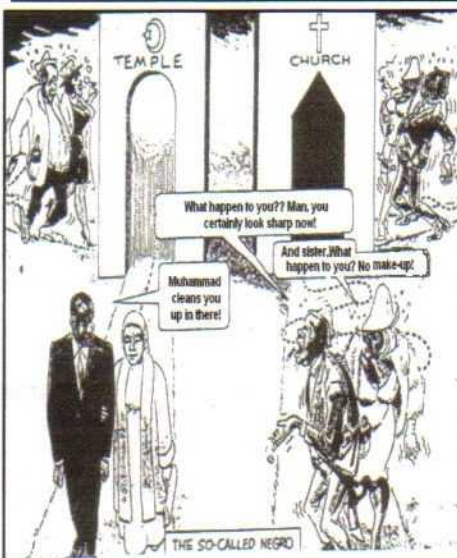
